# **#1** Arrival

- Event area/finish area: Richard-Strauss-Platz
- Registration: in the concert hall (on the event site)
- Address: Richard-Strauss-Platz, 82467 Garmisch-Partenkirchen

# #2 Parking facilities

- The event parking lot is located at the ice stadium (Am Eisstadion 1, 82467 Garmisch-Partenkirchen) and is about 750 meters away from the start/finish line
- If you have your accommodation near the event site, we ask you to park your car there
- There are no special ZUT camping sites, so please use the official camping and overnight accommodation sites

## #3 Registration / start number distribution

The race number distribution is located in the concert hall at the north-western end of the Expo Area in Garmisch-Partenkirchen.

You can only pick up your race number in person.

To avoid delays, please remember the following when registering:

- Identity card/driver's license
- Printed and signed disclaimer with QR code
- Viewed and confirmed online briefing

The compulsory equipment will only be checked before the start, not at the start number distribution.

You should have already received your declaration of liability with your personal QR code, which we need to issue your race number. If not, you can download and print it out.

## #4 Track and safety briefing

The **general and mandatory briefing takes place online**. Please watch the video in full and confirm that you have seen it. We can only give you your starting documents if you have seen the briefing and confirmed this by checking the box below.

#### You should have recieved your Briefing link on June 9th by mail.

The general final route and weather update will take place on Thursday evening as part of the welcome event at 6 pm on Richard-Strauss Platz (not a compulsory event).

## **#5 Mandatory equipment**

- The carrying of **equipment/clothing** during the competition will be checked before the start and randomly at the checkpoints
- Failure to carry the equipment/clothing will be penalized with disqualification
- Please make sure that your **cell phone** can also make calls abroad
- The detailed list of mandatory equipment and all other important information can be found under the following button
- You can find the **GPX file** or the **route map** under the altitude profile of the route info on the website

### **#6 Start times**

Entry to the start area incl. equipment check, from 45 minutes before the start, short and final briefing 15 minutes before the start

## **#7** Clothes transportation / drop bag

A drop bag can be handed in at the start up to 30 minutes before the race. This will then be transported to the finish and can be collected there.

For the long distances, additional drop bags can be accepted for the refreshment points.

Ehrwald Trail and Ultratrail 1 additional bag each for the V5 Hubertushof

ZUT100, 2 more bags for V3-100 in Biberwier and the V7 Schloss Elmau
